

Option X29 Nature and Climate

Identified and defined terms	X29 X29.1	<p>(1) The Nature and Climate Requirements are the requirements relating to nature and climate stated in the Scope.</p> <p>(2) The Nature and Climate Plan is the <i>nature and climate plan</i> or is the latest nature and climate plan accepted by the <i>Service Manager</i>. The latest nature and climate plan accepted by the <i>Service Manager</i> supersedes previous Nature and Climate Plans.</p> <p>(3) The Nature and Climate Partners are the people or organisations who contribute to the achievement of the Nature and Climate Requirements and are identified in the Nature and Climate Requirements.</p>
Collaboration	X29.2	<p>The <i>Service Provider</i> collaborates with other Nature and Climate Partners as stated in the Nature and Climate Requirements.</p>
Early warning	X29.3	<p>The <i>Service Provider</i> and the <i>Service Manager</i> give an early warning by notifying the other as soon as either becomes aware of any matter which could adversely affect the achievement of the Nature and Climate Requirements.</p>
Nature and climate plan	X29.4	<p>(1) If a nature and climate plan is not identified in the Contract Data, the <i>Service Provider</i> submits a first nature and climate plan to the <i>Service Manager</i> for acceptance within the period stated in the Contract Data.</p> <p>(2) The Nature and Climate Plan shows how the <i>Service Provider</i> plans to meet the Nature and Climate Requirements.</p> <p>(3) Within two weeks of the <i>Service Provider</i> submitting a nature and climate plan for acceptance, the <i>Service Manager</i> notifies the <i>Service Provider</i> of the acceptance of the nature and climate plan or the reasons for not accepting it. A reason for not accepting a nature and climate plan is that</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • it does not comply with the Nature and Climate Requirements or • it will not allow the <i>Service Provider</i> to Provide the Service. <p>(4) The <i>Service Provider</i> submits a revised nature and climate plan to the <i>Service Manager</i> for acceptance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • within the <i>period for reply</i> after the <i>Service Manager</i> has instructed it to and • when the <i>Service Provider</i> chooses to.
Disclosure	X29.5	<p>The Parties may use, disclose and publicise information relating to nature and climate as stated in and for the purposes stated in the Nature and Climate Requirements.</p>
Service Provider's proposals	X29.6	<p>(1) The <i>Service Provider</i> may propose to the <i>Service Manager</i> that the Scope is changed in order to reduce the impact of the operation, maintenance or demolition of the Affected Property on nature and climate.</p> <p>(2) If the <i>Service Manager</i> is prepared to consider the change, the <i>Service Provider</i> submits a quotation which comprises</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a detailed description, • an analysis of the reduction in the impact of the operation, maintenance or demolition of the Affected Property on nature and climate, • an analysis of the resulting risks to the <i>Client</i>,

- any changes to the Prices and Performance Table,
- a revised plan showing any changes to the timing of the *service*.

(3) The *Service Manager* consults with the *Service Provider* about a quotation. The *Service Manager* replies within the *period for reply*. The reply is acceptance of the quotation or the reasons for not accepting it. The *Service Manager* may give any reason for not accepting the quotation.

(4) The *Service Manager* does not change the Scope as proposed by the *Service Provider* unless the *Service Provider's* quotation is accepted.

(5) When a quotation to reduce the impact of the operation, maintenance or demolition of the Affected Property on climate is accepted the *Service Manager* changes the Scope, the Prices and the Performance Table accordingly and accepts the revised plan. The change to the Scope is not a compensation event.
