

'Collaboration' noun. The situation of two or more people working together to create or achieve the same thing.




Business


- In our industry, 'how' and 'what' susceptible to change

- Set motivations (KPIs, Performance tables etc...)





- Managing disruptive influences






Where to spend our energy pre-contract




What a missed opportunity looks like

- Lots of effort invested in Contract Data, zclauses and pricing
- But often doesn't speak to business case
- Scope is verbose, ambiguous, fragmented, incomplete
- Poor or no Programme
- Contractor late to the project
- Over reliance on Cl.16 and X21 post contract
- Becomes reactive, unpredictable, costly and late





Align before you sign



Governance

- Lack of empowerment
- Financial limits on decisions
- Board participation
- Payment based on forecast

Operations

- Defined Cost capture (SCC rules)
- 'Estimating' skills
- Compliance with NEC timings
- Instructions prior to quotations
