

Introduction

- We are discussing the use of
 - NEC4 Engineering and Construction Contract (ECC)
 - secondary Option X22 Early Contractor involvement (used only with Options C and E)
- We will focus on a middle ground scheme, that is where sufficient development work has been done to have confidence in the Budget
- We will then look at 2 extremes where we can:
 - when the *Client* has designed the *works*, it's 100% complete but we want to ECI the design, challenging it for safety, buildability etc and negotiate the Prices.
 - when the Client just says e.g. "design & build a road from A to B" with a Budget of £20m.



Contract preparation

- Specify information required by Client
- Set out how information is used in the contract



Supplier selection

- How to provide information required by Client
- How information is used in selection process



Contract management

- Submissions in Stage One what to include, how to review, status of accepted proposals
- Level of detail required
- Assessing Prices for Stage Two
- Timescale for deciding to proceed
